

EFFECTIVE Sept 17, 2022 TO: All Californians SUBJECT: Requirements for Visitors in Acute Health Care and Long-Term Care Settings

State Public Health Officer Order of September 17, 2022

Visitors must continue to comply with <u>CDPH Masking Guidance</u> while visiting in indoor settings and should continue to maintain all current infection prevention practices to continue protecting these most vulnerable populations. All visitors must:

- WEAR A WELL-FITTED MASK WITH GOOD FILTRATION (N95, KF94, KN95, or surgical masks are preferred over cloth face coverings) at all times during any visitation at the facility;
- WEAR ANY OTHER PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE) while in the patient's or resident's room that facility personnel deem appropriate to the situation; and
- PHYSICALLY DISTANCE from facility personnel and other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all times during any visitation at the facility.



By signing in as a visitor at Barlow Respiratory Hospital, I attest that I do not have active COVID-19 infection, I am free of COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, sore throat) and I agree to comply with masking guidance and maintain social / physical distancing.
