



VISITING Barlow Respiratory Hospital Los Angeles

Thank you for trusting Barlow Respiratory Hospital with your loved one's care. We welcome you.

For Barlow Respiratory Hospital Los Angeles:

- Visitors enter through the front door at Main Entrance to **check in at the security desk.**
- Visitation is permitted daily from 9am-9pm
- **Two (2) family members allowed to visit the patient at a time.** This helps us maintain safe distancing within the patient room.
- **Visitors who wish to tour the hospital in advance of patient admission must have a scheduled appointment and show proof of COVID vaccination**
- **Visitors must follow all safety protocols:**
 - Temperature check
 - Provide proof of vaccination or negative COVID test
 - **If NOT vaccinated or INCOMPLETE vaccination as per CDPH guidelines, visitors must provide proof of negative PCR test within 2 days or antigen test within one day**

Thank you for your cooperation. We follow California Department of Public Health (CDPH), Los Angeles County Department of Public Health ([LAPDH](#)) and Centers for Disease Control ([CDC](#)) safety protocols to maintain the safety of our patients and staff during the COVID-19 pandemic. Your Barlow Respiratory Hospital nursing team will assist in maintaining communication with your loved one in our care, including scheduling visits whenever possible.

Requirements for Visiting Hospitals and Nursing Homes

Planning a visit to a hospital or nursing home?
Here's what you need to know. Read the [full requirements](#).

#1 You'll Need To Show Proof Of Vaccination Or A Negative COVID Test

Visitors to hospitals and nursing homes must show [proof of vaccination](#) for COVID-19 or a negative [COVID test](#) (taken within one day of visitation for antigen tests, and within two days of visitation for PCR tests). Some exceptions apply. Read the [full requirements](#).

This applies to anyone more than two years old (including those who cannot be vaccinated due to age or other reasons).

Exceptions May Also Include:

- If you're visiting someone in critical condition and death may be imminent.
- If you're a parent/guardian of a child seeking emergency care.
- If you're supporting a labor and delivery patient or visiting for baby bonding.
- If you're a support person for someone with a disability who is seeking emergency care.
- If you're supporting someone during a hospital visit for outpatient services.
- If you're on duty as a fire, police, or ambulance worker.



#2 You'll Need to Wear a Face Covering and Physically Distance at All Times

Visitors must wear a well-fitting face covering with good filtration (N95, KF94, KN95, or surgical masks are preferred over cloth face coverings) at all times.

Visitors must also physically distance from other patients/residents/visitors that are not part of their group at all times.
