



BIOGRAPHY FOR AMIT MOHAN, PhD, FACHE, FACMPE

In November 2015 Amit Mohan, PhD, FACHE, FACMPE, became the President and Chief Executive Officer of Barlow Respiratory Hospital in Los Angeles, California. Amit was identified through a nationwide search and is an experienced leader with over 20 years of clinical and leadership expertise in healthcare.



Previously Amit, served as Executive Director for Shore Rehabilitation Institute in Brick, New Jersey. He functioned in a CEO capacity for the not-for-profit rehabilitation hospital established as a joint venture by two of the leading New Jersey health systems. Under his leadership, achievements included the expansion of access to care, addition of new programs, improved patient outcome, community engagement and team member experience. He was also credited with achieving solid financial performance and consistent growth. Previously, he held various leadership positions across the post-acute continuum and in acute care hospitals.
